### 2. IMPORTANT NOTE:

- (a) Please read the Information Bulletin of Teacher Eligibility Test-Nov-2023 carefully before filling the Online Application Form.
- (b) Candidate can apply only ONLINE for Teacher Eligibility Test- Nov-2023 through website <[www.hpbose.org](http://www.hpbose.org)>
- (c) The application for Teacher Eligibility Test- Nov-2023 has been made completely online with the facility to upload Bio data, photograph, signature & Fee detail of the applicant. The applicants are hereby advised to keep the scanned images of photograph and signatures ready in JPG format before applying online.
- (d) **Candidate should enter his/her particulars in capital Letters i.e. Name, Father's Name, Mother's Name & Date of Birth as per his/her Secondary Education Board / 10th Class certificate. Candidates are advised to check and ensure the spellings of such entries carefully while filling the columns of online application. Please note that no request for any change in particular will be accepted under any circumstances after the specified date for online correction would over.**
- (e) The applicant must have to submit his /her valid and active E-mail ID and Mobile Number while filling of Application Form, so that Board may use electronic mode of communication while contacting him/her at different stages of examination process.
- (f) **The candidate should satisfy his/her eligibility before applying and shall be personally responsible in case if he/she is not found eligible as per the given eligibility criteria at any stage.**

### 5. MODE AND METHOD OF ONLINE APPLICATION

1.	Visit official website of HPBoSE i.e <a href="http://www.hpbose.org">www.hpbose.org</a> ; click on "TET NOV/ Vacancy" Option and then select TET Nov-2023 link for filing the online application. a) After successful submission of data/ detail an Application number will be automatically generated. Candidates should keep Application Number for future references. b) If application number forgotten then click on "Forget Application No." and application number can be retrieved. c) Upload valid detail, photo, signatures and submit declaration. d) For Online activity access and to download Admit Card use "Application Number" as ID and Date of Birth as password. e) Candidate should keep a Print of confirmation Page with him/her.
2.	Before applying candidates in their own interest are advised to go through the detail instructions PROSPECTUS and also available on the website ( <a href="http://www.hpbose.org">www.hpbose.org</a> ) of the Board carefully.
3.	Before applying candidates must ensure that the all detail they have filled on the online application are correct. Select TET subject, category, sub-category etc. carefully.

4.	The candidates seeking reservation benefits available for SC/ ST/OBC/Physical Handicapped (PHH) must ensure that they are entitled to such reservation as per eligibility prescribed in the PROSPECTUS. They should also be in possession of the certificates in the prescribed format in support of their claim at the time of interview as per Govt. norms. The eligibility shall be finally verified by the concerned recruiting agency / appointing authority.
5.	Candidates with disability of 40% or more only would be considered as Handicapped for reservation, wherever, such reservation is applicable.
6.	Mobiles including earphones and connected cords and other electronic gadgets are banned within the premises of the examination centres. Possession of such equipment whether in use or in switched off mode, during the examination will be considered as use of unfair means. Candidature of such candidates will be cancelled.
7.	The Board encourages candidates to apply online. Submission of online application avoids data discrepancies, Non/wrong delivery of admit cards etc. As admit card can be downloaded from the website of the Board.
8.	The Board will not undertake detailed scrutiny of applications for eligibility and other aspects at the time of written examination and therefore the candidature of the candidate is accepted only provisionally. The candidates are advised to go through the requirements of minimum educational qualification etc. and satisfy themselves that they are eligible before applying and shall be personally responsible in case he/she is not eligible to apply as per the given eligibility criteria. It is to be noted that if a candidate has been allowed to appear in the Himachal Pradesh Teacher Eligibility Test it does not imply that the candidate's eligibility has been verified. - c) BA with at least 45% marks with Urdu as an elective subject and 1-year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed.) in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations issued from time to time in this regard.

**OR**

- d) BA with at least 50% marks with Urdu as an elective subject and 1-year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed.) Special Education.

**OR**

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- e) B.T. with 50% marks followed by B.A. Examination (English & one additional subject with 50%marks from a recognized University and 1-year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed.)

**OR**

- f) M.A. (Urdu) with at least 50% marks from a recognized University and 1 year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed.)

**Note:-I.**

- (a) Adecb-Kamil from jamia Urdu Aligarh will be considered/equivalent to B.A with Urdu.  
(b) Moallim-e Urdu from jamia Urdu Aligarh will be considered/equivalent to B.Ed.for teaching Urdu.

**AND**

**Note:-II.** Pass in Urdu Language Teacher Eligibility Test conducted by H.P.Board of School Education Dharamshala. Provided that the incumbents who have already qualified the Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by the H.P. Board of School Education Dharamshala shall also be eligible subject to the condition as laid in para-II of guidelines issued by the National Council for Teacher Education vide Notification No. 76-4/2010/NCTE/Acad. Dated 11.2.2011.

**9.9 Relaxations:**

**Note (1).** Relaxation upto 5% in minimum educational qualification and also in minimum qualifying marks for TET to the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/PHH categories of Himachal Pradesh.

**Note (2).** Candidates pursuing any of the teacher Education Programme in its final year (recognized by NCTE or the RCI, as the case may be) specified in the Gazette of India notification dated 25th August, 2010 are eligible for appearing in the TET examination.

**Note:**

- a) Please ensure that all the professional qualifications/diplomas/degrees/certificate referred to above as minimum eligibility conditions must have been recognized by the NCTE. So far as the latest list of the recognized teacher education institutions, recognized courses offered at elementary level are concerned, this information is available at the NCTE website <<https://ncte.gov.in/Website/Index.aspx>>, the detailed information about courses approved by Rehabilitation Council of India is available at the RCI website <[www.rehabcouncil.nic.in/programmers/courses](http://www.rehabcouncil.nic.in/programmers/courses)>
- b) The Candidate should satisfy his/her eligibility before applying and shall be personally responsible in case he/she is not eligible to apply as per the given eligibility criteria. It is to be noticed that if a candidate has been allowed to appear in the Himachal Pradesh Teacher Eligibility Test it does not imply that the candidate's eligibility has been verified. It does not vest any right with the candidate for appointment. The eligibility shall be finally verified, by the concerned recruiting agency / appointing authority.

**10. PATTERN FOR TEACHER ELIGIBILITY TEST**

There shall be one question paper in four different series having questions of multiple-choice/objective type, carrying 150 questions of one mark each to be attempted within 150 minutes. **There shall be 60% minimum qualifying marks.** There shall be no negative marking. A candidate shall have to choose the correct answer and shade against the appropriate choice in the OMR response sheet with **blue/black ball point pen** adhering to the

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instructions provided. As the answers will be given with blue/black ball point pen by darkening the appropriate circle, the candidates will have no option to change the answers once given. Therefore, before darkening the circle, correct option/answer may be ensured.

12. **Validity:**

The Validity Period of HP TET qualifying certificate for appointment will be for life time for all categories. There will be no restriction on the number of attempts a person can take for acquiring a TET certificate. **A person who has qualified TET may also appear again for improving his/her score.**

13. **Applicability:**

TET shall apply to a school of the H.P./State Government/local authority referred to sub-clause(i) of clause(n) of section-2 of the RTE Act and a school referred to in sub-clause (ii) of clause(n) of section -2 of the RTE Act in the State. A school referred to in sub clause (iv) of clause(n) of section-2 of the RTE Act may exercise the option of considering either the TET conducted by the State Government or the TET conducted by the Central Government.

14. **Age Limit:**

There is no upper age limit to apply for the TET. The age criteria are to be considered by the appointing authority at the time of appointment as per R&P Rules.

## 18. USE OF CALCULATING DEVICES/ PHONES/ WRITTEN/ TEXTUAL MATERIAL: -

Use of Calculators, Smart watches with Facilities of Calculator, Cellular/ Smart Phones & textual material ie formula text, calculation text etc. are strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall. Candidates are also strictly forbidden from carrying any Textual Material printed or written, bits of paper, envelope or any other material into the Examination Hall except the Admit Card.

### 18.1 **Candidates are advised to carry only the following with them into the examination venue:**

- i. Admit card along with Self Declaration (Undertaking) if any downloaded from the HPBOSE Website (a clear printout on A4 size paper) duly filled in.
- ii. A simple transparent Blue/Black Ball Point Pen.
- iii. Additional photograph, to be pasted on the attendance sheet.
- iv. Personal hand sanitizer (50 ml).
- v. Personal transparent water bottle.

## 19. ADMIT CARD:

- i. The Admit Card shall be issued only to those candidates who have submitted their Application Form complete in all respects within the stipulated time frame and who fulfils the minimum eligibility criteria laid down for the purpose.
- ii. Admit Card can be downloaded from the Board's Website [www.hpbose.org](http://www.hpbose.org) 4 days before the exam. The admit cards shall not be dispatched by post/fax or sent by E-mail. The candidate will appear in the examination at the given Centre on the date and timing as indicated in his/her Admit Card.
- iii. Admit Card is not transferable to any other person. Impersonation is legally punishable/cognizable offence.
- iv. The Admit Card will contain candidate's name, roll number, photograph, signature of the candidate, address of the examination center and test schedule.
- v. The Admit Card once received by the candidate should be carefully gone through and discrepancy, if any, should immediately be brought to the notice of the Board.
- vi. No candidate will be allowed to appear at the examination Centre, other than that allotted to him/her in his/her Admit Card. The candidates are advised to read the instructions on the Admit Card carefully.
- vii. Application form which is not submitted online or incomplete shall not be considered and no Admit card shall be issued to such candidates.
- viii. If any candidate found any discrepancies in these particulars i.e. (In Candidate Name, Father Name, Category, Sub-category) mentioned in the admit card then the candidate can file offline application with supporting documents for correction in

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these particulars within the stipulated period (as per Amended examination regulation Rule 14.2.4) i.e. between the 15 days from the date of issuance of admit card. The requests received after stipulated period shall be dealt with vide rule 14.2.5.

**Note:**

- a. In no case, the duplicate Admit Card would be issued at the Examination Centres.
- b. The candidates must not mutilate the Admit Card or change any entry made therein.
- c. Candidates are advised to preserve their Admit Cards in good condition for future reference.
- d. No Admit Card shall be issued to the candidates whose applications are found to be incomplete for any reasons (including indistinct/ doubtful photographs/unsigned Applications) or who do not fulfil the eligibility criteria for the examination.

**20. Evaluation and Declaration of Results:**

(i) The Provisional Answer Key of the written examination shall be published after last day of the written exam at Official website of the Board. The instructions for filing objections shall be published separately by the Paper setting section well in time.

However;

- a) Objections shall be sought from the examinees within 6 days from the date of publication of the provisional answer key. No application for objections received in office after stipulated time will be entertained as it cause unwanted delay in result declaration.
- b) Written objections received through e-mail or by post alongwith abstract of reference and facts shown under relevant page of concerned authentic book shall be considered and placed before subject expert.
- c) Report of subject expert shall be considered final and will be incorporated for Final Answer Key and shall be published as " Final Answer Key " on the official website for public interest in information.
- d) The result shall be prepared as per final answer key and no objections regarding Final answer key shall be entertained.

(ii) A fully computerized system has been adopted for the evaluation of the answer scripts optical mark reader (OMR) for the preparation of the results. Since the evaluation will be error free under the above system, there is no provision for revaluation or rechecking of the answer scripts or recounting of the marks scored. The result of TET NOV-2023 will be available on Board's Website <[www.hpbose.org](http://www.hpbose.org)>.

4. A seat indicating Roll Number will be allotted to each candidate. Candidates should find and sit in their allocated seats only. In case a candidate ventures to change his/her seat and does not sit on the seat allotted to him/her could face cancellation of candidature. No plea would be entertained in this regard.
5. The candidate should ensure that the Question Paper provided is for admission in the applied class. In case, the class of the Question Paper is other than his/her opted class, the same may be brought to the notice of the Invigilator concerned.
6. The candidates may approach the Centre Superintendent/Invigilator in the room for any assistance, first aid emergency, or any other information during the course of the examination.
7. In case a candidate, furnishes false information, his/her candidature will be cancelled and his/her result will not be declared.
8. For those who are unable to appear on the scheduled date of test for any reason, re-test shall not be held by the HPBoSE under any circumstances.

**Note:** - Candidates shall appear at their own cost at the Centre on the date as indicated in their Admit Card issued by the HPBOSE Under no circumstances the choice of cities for the Centre and shift provided in the Admit Card shall be changed.

## **27: UNFAIR MEANS PRACTICES AND BREACH OF EXAMINATION RULES**

**27.1. Definition:** Unfair Means practice is an activity that allows a candidate to gain an unfair advantage over other candidates. It includes, but is not limited to:

- a) Being in possession of any item or article which has been prohibited or can be used for unfair practices including any stationery item, communication device, accessories, eatable items, ornaments, or any other material or information relevant or not relevant to the examination in the paper concerned;
- b) Using someone to write examination (impersonation) or preparing material for copying;
- c) Breaching examination rules or any direction issued by HPBoSE in connection with Aforesaid examination;
- d) Assisting other candidates to engage in malpractices, giving or receiving assistance of any kind directly or indirectly or attempting to do so;
- e) Contacting or communicating or trying to do so with any person, other than the Examination Staff, during the examination time in the Examination Centre;
- f) Threatening any of the officials connected with the conduct of the examination or threatening any of the candidates;
- g) Using or attempting to use any other undesirable method or means in connection with the examination;
- h) Manipulation and fabrication of online documents viz. Admit Card, Score Card, Self-Declaration, etc.;
- i) Forceful entry in /exit from Examination Centre/Hall;
- j) Use or attempted use of any electronic device after entering the Examination Centre;
- k) Affixing/uploading of wrong/morphed photographs/ signatures on the Application Form/Admit Card;
- l) Creating obstacles in smooth and fair conduct of the examination.
- m) Any other malpractices declared as Unfair Means by the HPBoSE.

**27.2. Punishment** for using unfair means practices: During the course of, before, or after the examination if a candidate indulges in any of the above or similar practices, he/she shall be deemed to have used unfair practices and booked under UNFAIR MEANS (U.F.M.) case.

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## 28 MISCELLANEOUS:


### 1. Correspondence with HPBoSE

All the correspondence should preferably be addressed by e-mail. The email query shall be addressed only if it is not anonymous and contains the name, postal address, and contact number of the sender. An email containing vague or general queries and other queries as contained in the Information Bulletin / Prospectus shall not be entertained. Queries shall not be entertained from a person claiming to be representatives, associates, or officiates of the applicant candidate.

The following information shall not be revealed by phone or email:

- a) Internal documentation/status.
- b) The internal decision-making process of HPBOSE Any claim/counterclaim thereof.
- c) Dates and venue of internal meetings or name of the staff/officers dealing with it.
- d) Any information which cannot be revealed in the opinion of HPBOSE.
